# How to Apply

- Download the latest version of the SEMCO ENERGY Gas Company's (SEMCO) Commercial and Industrial (C&I) Program rebate application, write "Michigan Saves" at the top of the form, and submit it to ciapplications@clearesult.com as your reservation application.
- 2. Find an authorized Michigan Saves contractor to help you apply for Michigan Saves financing. To find a list of authorized contractors, visit www.MichiganSaves.org.
- 3. A preliminary reservation letter will be issued by SEMCO's C&I Program detailing the anticipated incentive. This letter must be attached to your application to Michigan Saves for financing.
- 4. Once Michigan Saves approves financing, a confirmation email will be sent to the customer, contractor, and SEMCO. Please do not begin your project until you have received a reservation letter. You then have 90 days—or until November 30, 2020, whichever is first—to complete the project.
- 5. A final application must be submitted to SEMCO within 60 days of project completion—or by November 30, 2020, whichever is first.
