- Download the latest version of the DTE Energy Small Business Program application and worksheet and submit it as your incentive reservation application.
- 2 Find an authorized Michigan Saves contractor to help you apply for Michigan Saves financing. To find a list of authorized contractors, visit MichiganSaves.org.
- 3 The DTE Energy Small Business Program will issue a preliminary reservation letter detailing your expected incentives. Attach this letter to your financing application to Michigan Saves; the value of awarded incentives will determine the actual interest rate. (The incentives will not be paid to the customer but will be assigned to Michigan Saves to "buy down" the interest rate.)
- 4 Once Michigan Saves approves financing, a confirmation email will be sent to you, the contractor, and DTE Energy. You then have 90 days—or until November 30, 2023, whichever is first—to complete the project. A final application must be submitted to DTE Energy within 60 days of completion of the project.
- 5 If eligible for additional utility incentives, you must submit a final application to DTE Energy within 60 days of project completion.
